The National Hydrogen Materials Alliance



Goals

- New materials that improve the efficiency and economics of hydrogen generation, storage and use
- Draw together Australian expertise in the above fields to work in an "alliance" mode
- Focus this expertise into the most promising R&D direction for Australian conditions
- Formal program launch November 2006



The National Hydrogen Materials Alliance



- Funding approx. \$2M/year (\$1M cash from CSIRO, matched by \$1M in-kind from participants) for an initial life of 3 years
- 12 university & research organisation participants from around Australia
- Activities are split into two Streams
 - Stream 1: generation and end use
 - Stream 2: storage



Sustainable Energy Transport for Perth (STEP)



- Additional \$1.75m to extend the Perth Fuel Cell Bus Trial for a further 12 months, to September 2007
- Focus will be:
 - On technology transfer, in order to develop local industries
 - On overcoming technical hurdles such as wider availability of ultra-pure hydrogen and improving refueller reliability


