## Hydrogen Energy Ministerial Meeting ("HEM")

40<sup>th</sup> IPHE Steering Committee Meeting 4 - 5 October 2023 Washington DC, United States



- 6th Hydrogen Energy Ministerial Meeting held on September 25, 2023 (in-person and on-line) in Tokyo, as a part of the Tokyo GX Week.
- Chair's Summary includes:
  - A firm global <u>demand target</u> of hydrogen at 150Mt, in which up to 90M being renewable and low-carbon hydrogen, by 2030
  - Positive impact on the creation of new industries (e.g. electrolyser supply chain) and new jobs closer to 800,000, mostly in skilled position
  - Importance of standards and certification
  - Financing (World Bank's first participation)

- Total of 23 governments and international organizations participated.
- Nearly 600 people attended the sessions either in-person or on-line.
- Four workshops held on following themes:
  - Global Hydrogen Review 2023 Launch Event keynote speech by IEA
  - Standard & Certification panel discussion led by IPHE
  - Safety regulation, code and standard panel discussion by Japanese, Korean and EU reps
  - Financing panel discussion by World Bank, Lao, Germany, JBIC and Mitsui
